A special meeting of the Board of Education was held at the Administrative Center, 1854 East Broadway, Alton, Illinois at 8:42 a.m. on Tuesday, December 8, 2015.

Motion: Approval of Agenda of Special Meeting

It was moved by Ms. Monckton, seconded by Mr. Harris and carried unanimously that the Board of Education approved the agenda of special meeting.

It was moved by Mr. Harris, seconded by Ms. Monckton and carried unanimously that the Board of Education adjourn to a closed session meeting for the purpose of conducting a student disciplinary hearing.

Motion: Open Session

It was moved by Mr. Harris, seconded by Ms. Monckton and carried unanimously that the Board of Education resume in open session.

Motion: Action on Student Discipline Hearing

It was moved by Mr. Harris, seconded by Mr. Lauschke and carried unanimously that the Board of Education, after considering evidence and mitigation witnesses, finds as follows:

For the reasons and infractions identified and presented in closed session, student #199606, is expelled for a period of two years (December, 2015 – December 2017), with said expulsion to be effective immediately, and is further prohibited from attending or participating in any school

sponsored events and from being present on school district property for the duration of the expulsion. Student #199606 shall be entitled to enroll in the Alternative Special Education Program. Student may be eligible to return under Principal's Probation beginning January, 2017 with a record of good grades, attendance and discipline at the Alternative Education Program.
